**MOFA in the House** at the Margaret Harwell Art Museum, 421 N Main Street, Poplar Bluff, MO 63901 is a Missouri Fiber Artists (MOFA) members' exhibit. MOFA is a National organization. All residents of the US are welcome. Not juried, works will be accepted into the show, until gallery space is filled.

<b>Notifications Emailed:</b>	Sunday, April 2, 2023
<b>Delivery of Accepted Works:</b>	April 25 – 30, Ship to venue or hand deliver during gallery hours.
<b>Exhibit Dates:</b>	Saturday, May 6 – June 25, 2023
<b>Reception:</b>	Saturday, May 6, 6:00 – 8:00 Poplar Bluff throws a great party.
<b>Pick Up Dates:</b>	Tuesday, June 27 – July 2, during gallery hours

#### Entry Specifications:

- This gallery has a wide variety of sizes for wall installations. It will accommodate approximately 6 large pieces. Large works are encouraged. Enter them early to claim a location. Many spots are medium sized to quite small. Pedestals are available for 3D works.
- Works are to be no more than 72”H or 42”W
- Works can be wall hung or displayed on pedestals or surfaces.
- All works must be the artist's original concept.
- All pieces are to be ready to install – no exceptions.
- **Restrictions:** No source of electric, no perishable organic materials.

**Entry Fee:** An entry fee of work by an individual, up to 3 pieces, is \$15. An entry fee for collaborative work, up to 3 pieces, is a separate \$15. You may participate in one individual and one collaborative entry of up to 3 pieces each entry. Do NOT combine individual and collaborative works in a single entry.

- Read/Review the Call for Entry thoroughly.
- Prepare and name image/s as follows: An overall image, at 1200 pixels on the long side, label lastname\_firstname\_title\_1 Include a detail or alternate image when needed, size the same and label lastname\_firstname\_title\_1A

- Choose online OR Mail-in Entry and follow instructions below heading.

**Commission on Sales:** The Margaret Harwell Art Museum takes 20% commission on sales.

**Awards:** Awards of Recognition will be given at the reception, May 6, 2023.

**Publicity:** Regardless of copyright, Missouri Fiber Artists and venue reserve rights to use your submitted photographs, and to photograph the gallery, in order to use the images for reproduction in color or black and white; of all artworks submitted to *MOFA in the House*, for educational and publicity purposes.

**Insurance, Liability, and Sales:**

- An Insurance Block Policy is provided by The Margaret Harwell Art Museum for 80% of the sale price.
- Insurance value will be calculated as 80% of the sale price.
- During gallery open hours, the reception desk is staffed.
- All entries must include a sale price or (NFS) Not For Sale, and an insurance value.
- All reasonable care will be taken with your works. The Margaret Harwell Art Museum, or staff nor MOFA and members cannot be held responsible for theft or damage.
- Works sold during the exhibit will be held until the close of the exhibit.
- Payment to artists will be by check, mailed within about two weeks, from the city of Poplar Bluff, MO

**Delivery/Shipping:**

- Works are to be shipped or hand delivered in sturdy boxes.
- Keep your boxes as small as possible, DO NOT use packing peanuts.
- Attach your name and title to the back of each artwork, hanging devices, boxes and packing materials.
- Ship via FedEx, UPS or USPS, or hand deliver to:

- Include an alternate address on the box – if the gallery is not open, items will be delivered here:

- Include a return label for return shipping. Use blue tape to attach return labels to the inside flap of your box.
- Delivery & pick up should be during gallery hours: T-F 12-4, S&S 1-4 (Closed on Monday)

**Shipping and Pick Up at the end of the show:**

Work is to be shipped at the artist's expense. Artists who wish to have their work shipped back to them, must include prepaid shipping labels or stamps for return shipping. Cash and checks cannot be used. Shipped artwork submitted without pre-paid return shipping, will not be shipped without prior compensation.

Pick up at the venue is to be during gallery hours. Or, arrangements should be made before the pick-up date, by artists who cannot pick-up at designated pick up times. Also, inform the Exhibitions Committee, if someone will pick up for you. Without prior notification, the venue may not be able to release artworks to someone other than the artist. This venue can be flexible, when notification has been given.
